All eyes on Lily Allen

Lily Allen. She's an English rose, with kooky, upswept, jewel-hued eye make-up. A great look. I've seen Allen a couple of times now (on TOTP, on T4), with pea-green winged eyeliner and fluoro-pink upswept eyeliner. Her look was the brainwave of the make-up artist Mary-Jane Frost. "Lily and I sat down, talked through her particular style and then came up with the look. I felt her great sense of style would be complemented by an interesting, colourful, slightly quirky eye," says Frost. The eye make-up is by Kryolan Aquacolor from Charles Fox, the theatrical make-up outlet, and her foundation is Armani Hydra Glow.

I've long been in love with bright eye colours, and used to trawl Make Up For Ever, when it was on London's South Molton Street, for acid eyeliners. Nars has some lambent liquid eyeliners with which you can replicate the Allen look: a stinging peacock blue and a piquant teal green.

Last week, however, an amazing eyelining kit fell into my lap: Too Faced's Liquif-Eye Shadow Collection. This is a palette of 12 shadows, in everything from khaki to lime and violet. What you do is mix the eye-shadow liquifier, which is a clear fluid, with each powder, to get an incandescent liquid eyeliner. Genius. I tried the sky blue and the effect was glistening (if a little lumpy). Worth trying for the Lily Allen summer eye.
